Tuesday, October 10th - Monday, October 16th.

The Town of Morris public works department conducts a Town wide clean-up twice a year. The purpose of this program is to help everyone clean up their yards and household products that are otherwise hard to get rid of. A clean community promotes pride in your community.

- We ask that you please **separate** your tree trimmings & glass objects from the rest of your garbage to make this an easier process for our public works department.
- We also ask that you please **do not** place renovation materials at the curb.
- Old Appliances are welcome to be placed at the curb but freezers and refrigerators must be **tagged Freon free.**
- Please **do not** place any further materials at the curb after Monday October 16th as this is the last day for clean-up and the public works department will be starting at one end of Town and going through the whole Town to do a last sweep. Any material left out after this will not be picked up.
