Public Notice

ADDITIONS TO THE VOTERS LIST AND/OR PERSONAL SECURITY PROTECTION REQUESTS

In accordance with Section 36 of The Municipal Councils and School Boards Election Act (MCSBEA), the Town of Morris Voters List is open for changes or revisions.

- Any person who is eligible to vote in municipal elections in the Local Authority of the Town of Morris can have his or her name added to the Voters List, or have any information about the voter on the Voters List corrected.
- Any person can request to have his or her name and address obscured from the Voters list.

A person whose name has been obscured will receive a Personal Security Certificate and identification number. In a civic election, that person may only vote by Sealed Envelope Ballot and cannot vote in person at the regular or advance voting places.

Voter Eligibility

A person is eligible to have his or her name added to the Voters List if he or she is:

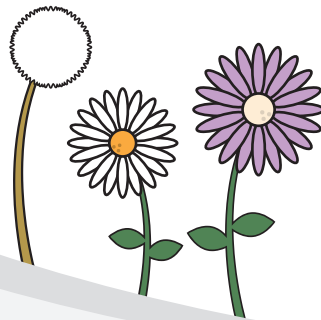
- A Canadian citizen and at least 18 years of age on election day; and
- A resident of the local authority for at least six months prior to election day, OR a registered owner of land in the municipality for at least six months prior to election day.

All changes to the voters list must be completed on or before September 18, 2018.
