FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When is my pickup day?

Your cart will be picked up **every-week** on Tuesdays.

Where do I place the cart?

We have set your cart down in the position to be emptied on your designated pickup day, **TUESDAY**. This is where the cart should be placed on your collection day.

What if I need assistance with my cart?

If you require assistance please contact us at 204-822-0327 as we offer a program for the elderly and disabled.

Will there be enough room for my garbage?

If you have an extra bag or two asking a neighbor can often work. For residents doing spring or fall cleaning MWM does offer larger front-load containers at very reasonable rates.

What about yard waste?

Please place yard waste in your compost cart during compost season.

USING THE CARTS

- Loose garbage should be bagged. This will keep loose papers from blowing onto street.
- Feel free to use plastic or paper bags of any size.
- Large items do not have to be bagged.
- Branches must be bundled and be able to fit in the bin. Branches should be no thicker than 6 inches.
- Please don't pack garbage in or exceed 250 pounds of waste.
- Only waste INSIDE the cart will be collected.
- Please notify us if your cart is damaged, stolen or vandalized.
- Please have the cart in it's place for pickup every-other-week by **7AM**.
- Pull the cart, don't push it - this will be much easier.
- Do not place hot ashes, construction debris, or hazardous waste, such as oil, paint cans with wet paint in the cart.
- Please keep your cart clean and take care of it. Do not paint or write on the cart.

PLEASE NOTE: Material placed outside the cart will NOT be collected.

PLACING THE CART

- Place the cart with the wheels against the curb.
- Have the front of the cart towards the street.
- Leave an arms length of space between the cart and any other object.
- Don't place the cart under an overhead obstruction.
- Place at the curb by 7 AM. We may arrive to your house at different times, having to the curb by 7 will ensure your cart gets emptied.
